Mayor Nelson called the meeting to order at 7:06 p.m.

Village Clerk Porter took roll. There was a quorum.

GENERAL STATEMENT/RULES OF ORDER (Announced by Mayor Nelson):

The meeting was streamed via Zoom. Mayor Nelson reviewed the public comment policy, which is available on the Village website.

RECOGNITIONS AND APPOINTMENTS:

1. A Proclamation Declaring October 2025 as Breast Cancer Awareness Month

Mayor Nelson read the Proclamation for Breast Cancer Awareness Month. Renee Basick accepted the Proclamation. Ms. Basick also provided information about “The Devil’s Playground” Halloween Haunted Yard Display that raises funds for an LGBTQ+ non-profit focus group called “*Haunters Against Hate*” that supports teen groups around the country.

2. A Proclamation Declaring October 20 – 26, 2025 as Friends of the Library Week

Mayor Nelson read the Proclamation for Friends of the Library Week to recognize how the Flossmoor Library is one of the cornerstones of the community.

PUBLIC PRESENT WISHING TO ADDRESS THE BOARD:

- 1. Warren Engelberg (Flossmoor resident):** Gave commentary about his perspectives on revolutionary reform throughout history.

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3. Vanessa Smith (Flossmoor resident): Discussed problems she has had with cars parking between the end of her driveway and the street corner. This is a frequent problem that causes safety issues since she lives across from a park. She requested that No Parking signs be placed between the end of her driveway and the street corner. Mayor Nelson advised that the Village would look into this issue.

4. Andrea Perry (Flossmoor resident): Voiced complaints about representations involving another Flossmoor resident that were made during the public comments at the October 6, 2025, Board meeting.

**Agenda Item #6 - Consideration of a Resolution of the Village of Flossmoor, Cook County, Illinois
Approving Salary Schedules for Fiscal Year 2025-2026**

Mayor Nelson called for a Motion to approve Agenda Item #6. Trustee Lofton so moved, Trustee Daggett seconded.

Trustee Mustafa requested that the term “salary” be changed to “salary ranges” in the resolution approving the salary schedule and asked for clarification about the salary ranges. Attorney Miller advised that this term could be amended, and Village Manager Wachtel answered Trustee Mustafa’s question about the salary ranges and noted that the only adjustment being made was the addition of the Community Service Officer II position. No other board members had comments and/or questions.

A vote on the Motion was presented and passed unanimously by a roll call vote.

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REPORTS OF COMMITTEES, COMMISSIONS AND BOARDS ACTION ITEMS:

Mayor Nelson stated there were none. Mayor Nelson expressed gratitude to: (a) Flossmoor's Green Commission for the parkway tree plantings over the weekend that brought the total number of new trees planted in the Village to almost 700 since 2021. Mayor Nelson recognized the volunteers for the tree plantings that included the Homewood Flossmoor High School football team and coaches, South Suburban Jack and Jill, members of AKA, Public Works, Stephanie Wright (Community Engagement Manager), Village Clerk Porter, and many neighbors. Mayor Nelson also gave a shout-out to the Village of Flossmoor's Public Art Commission for its ongoing fundraiser to benefit public art.

ACTION ITEMS

Agenda Item #7 – Presentation and Adoption of the Fiscal Year 2024-2025 Audit.

Mayor Nelson called for a Motion to approve this action item. Trustee Mitros so moved, and Trustee Daggett seconded.

This action item was presented by Ann Novoa, Finance Director, who advised that the Village received unmodified opinions on its financial statements (this is the highest of opinions). Brian LeFevre, the auditor from Sikich, presented further information about the results of the audit. Mr. LeFevre explained the comprehensive audit sections and praised the Village for achieving, for the 47th consecutive year, an award for excellent financial reporting! Mr. LeFevre explained the very high standards the Village must meet to achieve these favorable audit results and advised that the Village's financial statements met the highest level that could be achieved for financial reporting. Mr. LeFevre also advised that the audit process went very smoothly, was completed on time, and in accordance with the schedule.

Mayor Nelson congratulated the Village's finance department on achieving another unmodified opinion and excellent audit results and advised that the results be published under the Finance Department page on the Village's website. The Board also praised the Village's finance team for achieving another unmodified opinion.

Agenda Item #8 – Consideration of an Ordinance of the Village of Flossmoor, Cook County, Illinois Amending Chapter 103 and 150 of the Village of Flossmoor Municipal Code (Alcoholic Beverages)

Mayor Nelson called for a Motion to approve this action item. Trustee Daggett so moved, and Trustee Mitros seconded.

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This action item was presented by Village Manager Wachtel, who gave information about the continuation of this discussion from the October 6, 2025, Board Meeting in response to Tornado BP's request for a BW license. Village Manager Wachtel advised the Board about the amended ordinance for a Class BW-1 license that was drafted following the October 6, 2025, Board Meeting, which has limitations on sale hours and access for beer and wine. Village Manager Wachtel clarified that the ordinance as prepared had two mistakes both related to permitted sales hours; the permitted sales hours for Class P-GC and Class B-WO should not be changed from those that are currently in the code, and she requested that the ordinance be considered with that amendment which would not change those sales hours. Representatives from Tornado BP were present. Trustee Daggett confirmed that the Board was only voting on the creation of this new classification and not voting on awarding the license to Tornado BP during this meeting.

A vote on the Motion was presented with the amendment and passed by a roll call vote.

DISCUSSION ITEMS

Agenda Item #9 – Discussion of the Fiscal Year 2026-2031 Five Year Projections

This discussion item was presented by Village Manager Wachtel and Finance Director Novoa, who advised that this presentation was prepared to evaluate the Village's financial preparation and response to fiscal issues. This is a budget exercise and in addition to discussing our projections, they evaluated the methodology of the budget study, the findings, and how the projections compare to actual figures. Village Manager Wachtel reported that the Village is not experiencing financial distress, the Village has successfully sustained its operations, and the Village has made the right policy decisions to be in a strong financial position. Finance Director Novoa advised that, for purposes of this exercise, they take a very conservative approach. Village Manager Wachtel further advised regarding options for financial policies, allocating funds, avenues for increasing revenues, and service prioritizations and service modifications.

Mayor Nelson advised that she has been contacted by two more developers about southwest Flossmoor. Mayor Nelson also again clarified that the \$1.5 million operating deficit discussed last Spring was a planned operating deficit, that this was money that was outside of the Village's required minimum level reserves, and that those funds were available to cover a planned deficit. Mayor Nelson further advised that she is not in favor of the following: (a) A home rule option; (b) Additional taxes on utilities such as water; (c) Changes in pension contributions and/or the capital equipment fund, and (d) A future referendum absent any significant changes. Mayor Nelson advised she is in favor of reviewing the following: (a) Continued development; (b) A places for eating and amusement tax; (c) Evaluating a lower reserve policy; (d) Looking at ways to increase efficiency of different departments without cutting services; and (e) Moving operating expenses that support water and sewer systems away from the general fund to the water and sewer fund.

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The Board discussed the places for eating tax and when it would need to be implemented to be effective, how it would be a favorable way to increase revenue since it is a tax that is shared by those who are coming from outside of the Village, and why it is favorable since it is a pass-through tax. The Board also discussed focusing hard on economic development, whether to lower reserves, reducing expenditures, and continuing to be conservative with finances. With this Board feedback, staff will bring additional discussions to the Board.

OTHER BUSINESS

Agenda Item #10 – A Motion to go into Executive Session to Discuss the Employment of Specific Individuals, Property Acquisition, and Litigation

Mayor Nelson stated that the Board needed to go into Executive Session to discuss the sale of Village property, and before doing so asked if there was any other business. The Board responded as follows:

Trustee Mitros: No comments other than also congratulating Chief Estelle on receiving the Public Safety Award.

Clerk Porter: No Comments

Village Attorney Miller: Praised the Village for its excellent financial position.

Village Manager Wachtel: Advised that the Village is pursuing an actuarial analysis to study eliminating Tier 2 public safety pensions, and that the Village, even with the Cook County tax delay, remains in a strong financial position.

Mayor Nelson further announced that: (a) The Chicago Tribune and Chicago Architectural Center published stories about the tour of Flossmoor's Frank Lloyd Wright Home and that this was a successful event; (b) The third annual staff appreciation lunch was this upcoming Friday; (c) Flossmoor Social was opening this week, (d) October is National Woman's Small Business Month; and (e) Halloween is approaching and to be careful and drive safely.

Mayor Nelson called for a Motion to go into Executive Session to discuss the sale of Village owned property. Trustee Daggett so moved, and Trustee Mitros seconded. This motion was presented and passed by a roll call vote.

RE: **Consideration of an Ordinance of the Village of Flossmoor, Cook County, Illinois Amending Chapter 285 of the Village of Flossmoor Municipal Code (Home Occupations, Fines)**

On September 18, 2025, the Plan Commission held a public hearing to consider text amendments to the Flossmoor Zoning Ordinance regulating home occupations and establishing fines for violations.

The Village attorney and staff are requesting consideration of a text amendment to Section 285-21-2 B. of the Flossmoor Zoning Ordinance prohibiting certain Home Occupations. The following would be added to the list of prohibited home occupations:

“Swimming Pools as accessory to a dwelling unit in all residential districts shall not be rented to any person, group of persons, a business or an organization, whether for profit or non for profit, for any fee, remuneration or consideration.”

The intended purpose of this proposed amendment is to prohibit swimming pools from being rented. Recently, new websites and apps such as Swimply offer the rental of private residential swimming pools for parties and other events for a fee and staff is seeking to codify clearly that this is a prohibited occupation similar to “tourist homes” such as Airbnb or Vrbo.

In addition, the Village attorney and staff are requesting consideration a text amendment to Section 285-26-13 A. of the Flossmoor Zoning Ordinance which establishes fines for violations of zoning regulations. The proposed amendment would change the minimum fine from \$25 to \$100 and the maximum fine from \$500 to \$750 for each offense, which is permitted under Illinois Statute.

Section 285-26-13 A. would read as follows:

Any person who violates, disobeys, omits, neglects or refuses to comply with, or who resists enforcement of any provision of, this chapter shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$100 nor more than \$750 for each offense. Each day a violation is permitted to exist shall constitute a separate offense.

At the close of the public hearing, the Plan Commission unanimously recommended to amend the Zoning Ordinance as submitted by staff.

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF FLOSSMOOR, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS AMENDING
CHAPTER 285 OF THE VILLAGE OF FLOSSMOOR MUNICIPAL CODE**

WHEREAS, the Village of Flossmoor, Cook County, Illinois (the "Village") is a duly organized and validly existing non-home-rule municipality created in accordance with the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970 and the laws of the State; and,

WHEREAS, Chapter 285, Section 285-21-2 of the Flossmoor Municipal Code provides a list of all customary home occupations which are permitted to be conducted in any dwelling unit and those home occupations which are prohibited; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 285, Section 285-26-13 A. of the Flossmoor Municipal Code establishes fines for violations of the Flossmoor Zoning Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Trustees (the "*Corporate Authorities*") have determined that the rental of swimming pools which are an accessory to any dwelling unit to a residence is not a use to be permitted in any residential zoning district; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities desire to amend the Code to specifically prohibit the rental of swimming pools as a home occupation; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities desire to amend the Code to increase the fines imposed for violations of the Flossmoor Zoning Ordinance, all as hereinafter set forth.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Flossmoor, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: Chapter 285, subsection 285-21-2B of the Village of Flossmoor Municipal Code is hereby adding the following to said subsection B of Section 285-21-2:

Swimming Pools as accessory to a dwelling unit in all residential districts shall not be rented to any person, group of persons, a business or an organization, whether for profit or not-for-profit, for any fee, remuneration or consideration.

Section 2: Chapter 285, subsection 285-26-13A of the Village of Flossmoor Municipal Code is hereby amended as follows:

Any person who violates, disobeys, omits, neglects or refuses to comply with, or who resists enforcement of any provision of, this chapter shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$100 nor more than \$750 for each offense. Each day a violation is permitted to exist shall constitute a separate offense.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.

RE: **Consideration of a Renewal of an Intergovernmental Agreement for the Provision of Environmental Health Inspectional Services with the Cook County Department of Public Health**

Our intergovernmental agreement for health inspections with the Cook County Department of Public Health is up for renewal. The renewal would be for continuation of services from December 1, 2024, through November 30, 2025.

Per the agreement, the Department of Public Health will continue to provide inspectional services of foodservice establishments and retail food stores at a rate of \$100 per inspection, which is the same as in the previous agreement. The charge per inspection in the Fee Schedule contained in the Municipal Code is \$125, which reflects the Cook County charge plus \$25 for Village administrative costs.

Our experience with the Cook County Department of Public Health for this service continues to be excellent, and I am recommending that we renew. Attached are two copies of the Intergovernmental Agreement for the Provision of Environmental Health Inspectional Services with the Cook County Department of Public Health for signature, which may be returned to me for processing with Cook County.

INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR THE PROVISION OF ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH INSPECTIONAL SERVICES

This **AGREEMENT** entered into as of December 1, 2025 by and between the Village of Flossmoor, Cook County, Illinois a municipal corporation (hereinafter called the **VILLAGE**), and the County of Cook, Illinois a body corporate and politic (hereinafter called the **COUNTY**).

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, The **VILLAGE** wishes to provide environmental health inspectional services relating to food service sanitation and retail food store sanitation; and

WHEREAS, the **COUNTY** is willing to provide the **VILLAGE** with certain environmental health services through the work of its Department of Public Health, (hereinafter called the **DEPARTMENT**) upon the terms and conditions as hereinafter set forth; and

WHEREAS, the **COUNTY** is a home rule unit as provided in the 1970 Illinois Constitution (Art. VII, Sec. 6); and

WHEREAS, the **VILLAGE** is a municipality deriving its authority as provided in the Illinois Compiled Statutes (65 ILCS 5); and

WHEREAS, the 1970 Illinois Constitution (Art. VII, Section 10) and the Illinois Compiled Statutes (5 ILCS 220) provide authority for intergovernmental cooperation; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Compiled Statutes (55 ILCS 5/5-25013 (B) 5), provides that the **DEPARTMENT** may contract for the sale of health services; and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto seek to protect the health of the citizens of the **COUNTY** and the **VILLAGE** by undertaking the **AGREEMENTS** contained herein through their joint effort.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises, and such other considerations as hereinafter set forth, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. The **DEPARTMENT**, through its Environmental Health Division Staff, shall provide the following environmental services to the **VILLAGE**:
 - a. Make inspections as required by the food sanitation provisions of the Code of Ordinances of the **VILLAGE** (hereinafter called the **VILLAGE CODE**) of all food service establishments and retail food stores licensed or permitted by the **VILLAGE** as scheduled by the **VILLAGE** and the **DEPARTMENT** during the term of this **AGREEMENT** to assure compliance with the **VILLAGE CODE**;

- b. Reinspect all food service establishments and retail food stores to monitor the correction of violations identified at the time of the initial inspection pursuant to (a.) above;
 - c. Provide the **VILLAGE** with reports of inspections undertaken;
 - d. Report immediately to the **VILLAGE** on matters which in the opinion of the inspector are of serious concern;
 - e. Testify as required in any court cases brought by the **VILLAGE** for correction of food sanitation code violations cited pursuant to inspections conducted by the **DEPARTMENT**;
 - f. Review plans for any new or extensively remodeled food service establishment or retail food store in the **VILLAGE** to assure compliance with current Federal, State, **COUNTY**, and **VILLAGE** Food Service Establishment and Retail Food Store Regulations.
2. The **DEPARTMENT** agrees to furnish its employees with means of transportation to, from, and within the **VILLAGE** in order to carry out the duties and inspections as described herein.
3. The **VILLAGE** agrees:
- a. To maintain in force during the term and any extension of this intergovernmental **AGREEMENT**, ordinances or regulations at least equivalent to the **COUNTY** Food Service Establishment and Retail Food Store Ordinances;
 - b. To maintain files and records of inspections and licensing or permitting of food service establishments and retail food stores, and to provide the **DEPARTMENT** with one copy of inspection reports prepared by **DEPARTMENT** personnel and upon reasonable notice provide the **COUNTY** with access to said files and records;
 - c. To provide any legal action in the determination of the **VILLAGE** necessary to enforce the **VILLAGE** ordinances or regulations.
4. To provide the **DEPARTMENT** with the necessary authority to perform the duties and services referred to above.
5. The **DEPARTMENT** agrees to provide all of the services outlined in Paragraph Number 1 above, at a cost of **\$100.00 per inspection** billed to the **VILLAGE** for the term of the **AGREEMENT**.

6. The **VILLAGE** agrees to hold harmless and to indemnify the **COUNTY**, its Board members, officers, agents and employees from liabilities, costs, judgments, attorneys' fees or other expenses resulting from any negligence or act or failure to act under this **AGREEMENT** by the **VILLAGE**, its officers, agents or employees. The **COUNTY** agrees to hold harmless and to indemnify the **VILLAGE**, its Board members, officers, agents and employees from liabilities, costs, judgments, attorneys' fees or other expenses resulting from any negligence or act or failure to act under this **AGREEMENT** by the **COUNTY**, its officers, agents or employees. Nothing herein shall be construed to require the **VILLAGE** to indemnify the **COUNTY** for the negligence of the **DEPARTMENT** or its officers, agents, or employees; and further, nothing herein shall be construed to require the **VILLAGE** to indemnify or make any payments in connection with any claim for which the **COUNTY** or the **DEPARTMENT** otherwise would not be liable, nor shall it be construed to waive any defenses that the **COUNTY**, the **DEPARTMENT** or the **VILLAGE** may otherwise have to any such claim. Furthermore, nothing herein shall be construed to require the **COUNTY** to indemnify the **VILLAGE** for the negligence of the **VILLAGE** or its officers, agents or employees; and further, nothing herein shall be construed to require the **COUNTY** to indemnify or make payments in connection with any claim for which the **VILLAGE** otherwise would not be liable.
7. This **AGREEMENT** shall become effective as of December 1, 2025 and shall continue through November 30, 2026 unless otherwise terminated by either party as hereinafter provided. This **AGREEMENT** may be renewed on an annual basis by resolution of the corporate authority of both parties or with the written agreement of the parties through their designated representatives. For purposes of the renewal of the terms and conditions contained in this **AGREEMENT** the **COUNTY** authorizes the Chief of the Bureau of Health Services or the Director of the **DEPARTMENT** to renew on its behalf.
8. The parties hereto shall at any time during the term of this **AGREEMENT** have the right to terminate same upon 30 days written notice to the other party, said notice to be sent certified mail, return receipt to: Director, Cook County Department of Public Health, 10220 S. 76th Avenue, Room 250, Bridgeview, IL 60455; or the Village Manager, Village of Flossmoor, 2800 Flossmoor Road, Flossmoor, Illinois 60422-1186.
9. It is expressly agreed by the parties hereto that all environmental health staff members of the **DEPARTMENT** shall be deemed its employees and shall be under the sole supervision and control of the **DEPARTMENT**.

10. This intergovernmental **AGREEMENT** may be amended only by resolution of the corporate authority of each party hereto.
11. If any provision of this **AGREEMENT** is invalid for any reason, such invalid portion shall not render invalid the remaining provisions of this **AGREEMENT** which can be given effect without the invalid provision to carry out the intent of the parties as stated herein.
12. Neither party hereto may assign this **AGREEMENT** in whole or in part without the written consent of the other party.
13. The waiver by a party or any breach or failure of the other party to perform any covenant or obligation contained herein shall not constitute a waiver of any subsequent breach.
14. This **AGREEMENT** represents the entire **AGREEMENT** between the parties and supersedes any and all prior **AGREEMENTS**, whether written or oral. Any modification of this **AGREEMENT** shall be valid only if in writing and signed by all parties hereto.
15. This **AGREEMENT** shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Illinois.
16. All notices relating to the **AGREEMENT** shall be either hand delivered to the party or mailed to the party by certified mail, return receipt requested to all respective parties at addresses as both appear in Section 8 of this **AGREEMENT**.
17. None of the provisions of this **AGREEMENT** is intended to create nor shall be designed or construed to create any relationship between the **COUNTY** and the **VILLAGE** other than of independent entities contracting with each other hereunder solely for effecting the provisions of the **AGREEMENT**. Neither of the parties hereto nor any of their respective representatives shall be construed to be the agent, the employer or representative of the other. The **VILLAGE** and the **COUNTY** will maintain separate and independent managements and each has full unrestricted authority and responsibility regarding its own organization and structure.
18. The execution of this **AGREEMENT** by the **COUNTY** shall be subject to the authorization of the Cook County Board of Commissioners adopted in accordance with applicable law.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the undersigned governmental units have caused this **AGREEMENT** to be duly executed and attached herewith are copies of the respective resolutions authorizing the signing official to execute this **AGREEMENT**.

RE: Consideration of a Liquor License Request for
Tornado BP for a Class BW-1 License

The owners of Tornado BP had requested to sell liquor at their location at 3950 Vollmer Road for consumption off-premise (retail sales). After Board discussion on October 6, 2025, the Board created a class BW-1 license that has all the restrictions of Class BW (retail sales of beer and wine only, off-premise consumption) plus restricted access and more narrowly limits the hours of operation compared to other license classes. Specifically, the additional restriction limits access to locked cabinets and restricts access to the shelves and coolers after the permitted hours of sale. The permitted hours of sale terminate at 10:00 pm 7 days a week. The Board approved this classification at the October 20, 2025 Board meeting.

Tonight's consideration is whether to assign one license under this new class to Tornado BP. At the meeting on October 6, representatives of Tornado BP indicated that they remained interested in a retail license to sell beer and wine only with restricted access and terminate sales at 10:00 pm daily. If the Board is agreeable, a motion to approve a BW-1 license for Tornado BP should be approved.

RE: Discussion of E-Bike and E-Scooter Regulations

Recently, the Police Department has received an increase in questions and concerns regarding the use of electric bicycles and scooters throughout the Village. These concerns involve both the safety of riders and the potential risks to other community members, particularly in areas with pedestrian traffic and shared roadways. Members of the Police Command staff and Assistant Village Manager Bogue attended a session on e-bikes and scooters, researched the topic, and connected with our community partners on the subject.

In response, the Chief of Police is requesting that the Board of Trustees hold a discussion about the use and regulation of these modes of transportation to ensure that public safety remains the highest priority. The attached PowerPoint presentation outlines objectives, data and recommendations.

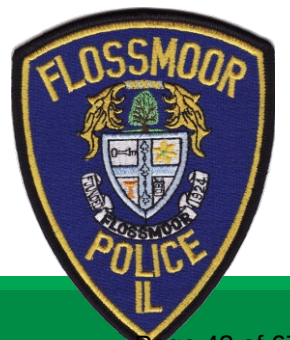


Background

There has been an observable increase in the use of E-Bike and E-Scooters by riders of all ages, creating a growing safety concern. Several municipalities have been addressing these concerns through ordinances and regulations (i.e. Deerfield, Elmhurst, Evergreen Park, Oak Lawn). In Flossmoor, Police have received 24 “mini-bike” complaints since 2023.

- ☐ Provide awareness of the current laws and provide clarifications on use of low-speed gas bicycles, e-bikes and e-scooters.
- ☐ Get direction from the Board of Trustees
- ☐ Create goals to:
 - ☐ Increase safety
 - ☐ Raise awareness

ELECRIC-POWERED BICYCLES



Low-Speed Electric Bicycles (625 ILCS 5/1-140.10)

An **e-bicycle** is one equipped with fully operable pedals, plus an electric motor of less than 750 watts. Illinois law subdivides e-bikes into three classifications:

- ☐ Class 1: Motor assists only when pedaling and stops at 20 MPH
- ☐ Class 2: Motor operates even when not pedaling and stops at 20 MPH
- ☐ Class 3: Motor assists only when pedaling and stops at 28 MPH

Specifically excluded from this definition are mopeds and “motor-driven cycles.”



E-Bike Riding Locations (625 ILCS 5/11-1517)

E-bikes can lawfully travel in the same locations as pedal-powered bicycles, including highways, streets and roadways. Low-speed e-bikes are specifically authorized for traveling within:

- ☐ Bicycle lanes
- ☐ Bicycle paths

“A person may not operate a low-speed electric bicycle on a sidewalk.”



Age Restrictions for Class 3 E-Bikes

- ☐ No one younger than age 16 can lawfully ride a Class 3 e-bike, defined as bikes that can reach 28 MPH.
- ☐ Those under age 16 may ride on a Class 3 e-bike as a passenger.





LOW-SPEED, ELECTRIC-POWERED SCOOTERS



Low-Speed Electric Scooters (625 ILCS 5/1-140.11)

Under Illinois' new definition, **low-speed electric scooters** must:

- ☐ Weigh less than 100 lbs.
- ☐ Have either two or three wheels
- ☐ Have handlebars and a floorboard that can be stood on while riding
- ☐ Be powered solely by an electric motor, as well as human power
- ☐ Be capable of traveling no faster than 10 MPH

Specifically excluded from this definition are mopeds and “motor-driven cycles.”



Age Restrictions for Low-Speed E-Scooters

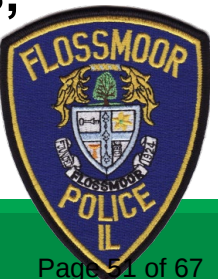
Illinois residents age 18 and older may own and operate a low-speed e-scooter without obtaining:

- ☐ A certificate of title (625 ILCS 5/3-102[10])
- ☐ A registration certificate (625 ILCS 5/3-402[10])
- ☐ An Illinois driver's license or permit (625 ILCS 5/6-102[9])



State Regulations for E-Scooters (625 ILCS 5/11-1518[b-l])

- ☐ No operation by anyone under age 18
- ☐ No operation on highways / state highways with posted speed limits >35 MPH
- ☐ Mandatory lights & reflectors if e-scooter is used at night
- ☐ Mandatory brake that can stop and hold the e-scooter
- ☐ Requirement to keep the e-scooter in good operating condition
- ☐ Prohibitions on siren use, carrying packages with both hands, multiple riders, attaching scooters to other vehicles and riding while under the influence



Local Regulations for E-Scooters (625 ILCS 5/11-1518[a])

An unusual feature of Illinois' e-scooter regulations is that the low-speed version's use is only permitted if a municipality or other unit of local government has specifically authorized its use within its jurisdiction.

However, such authorizations only apply to property that the rule-making authority owns, leases or manages. For example, a park district's regulation permitting low-speed e-scooter use doesn't apply to downtown city streets.



Local Rule-Making Authority (625 ILCS 5/11-1518[a])

State law authorizes several governmental entities to author regulations for operating low-speed e-scooters within their jurisdictions:

Municipalities • Park Districts

Forest Preserve Districts • Conservation Districts

These entities can make regulations for use on sidewalks, trails & other public rights-of-way where the operation of bicycles is permitted.

REGULATION EXAMPLES FROM OTHER MUNICIPALITIES





Orland Park

Under Village ordinance 9-12-3, it is **illegal** to operate E-bikes and E-scooters in the Village of Orland Park. This includes public streets, sidewalks, parking lots, bike paths and public parks.

WHAT IS AN E-BIKE?



E-Bikes are electric bicycles that:

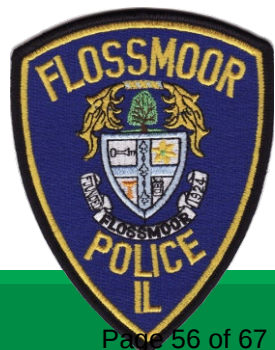
- Include motor assistance (motor less than 750 watts)
- Are equipped with fully operable pedals
- Require no driver's license

WHAT IS AN E-SCOOTER?

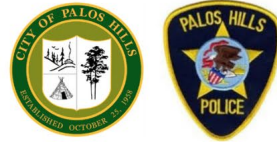


E-Scooters are devices that:

- Have two or three wheels, handlebars and a floorboard that can be stood upon while riding
- Weigh less than 100 pounds, powered by an electric motor and/or human power and has a maximum speed of 10 miles per hour

E-BICYCLES E-SCOOTERS ORDINANCE 2025-19



–

LOW SPEED E-BICYCLE

- Allowed on streets with a posted speed limit of 20mph or below.
- Not permitted in public parks.
- Not allowed on sidewalks.
- Must wear a helmet if under the age of 16.
- Must abide by rules of the road.

–

LOW SPEED E-SCOOTER

- Allowed only on sidewalks.
- Must be 18 years old or older to operate.
- Maximum speed is 10MPH.
- Not permitted in public parks.

–

HIGH SPEED E-BICYCLES AND SCOOTERS

- Must abide by the rules of the road.
- Not allowed on sidewalks, bike paths, or trails.
- Not permitted in public parks.
- Must be a licensed operator in Illinois.



E-BICYCLES / E-SCOOTERS

E-Bicycles and E-Scooters are not allowed at public parks



SAFETY EQUIPMENT REQUIRED

Lights and reflectors are required on E-Bicycles and E-Scooters at night. They must be labeled properly showing proper classification.

WHERE CAN I RIDE?

Ride on streets and sidewalks within Glen Ellyn.
No sidewalk riding in the Downtown (Central Business District).

WHERE CAN I PARK?

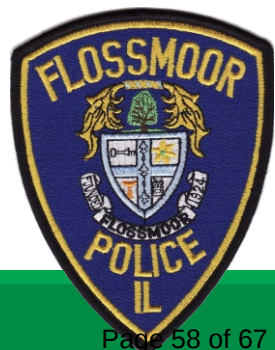
In designated racks or on sidewalks next to buildings within 2.5 feet of wall. *Must use racks only whenever possible in the Downtown (Central Business District).*

OPERATION RULES

- Speed: Must be safe for existing conditions.
- No use of personal mobility devices on roads ≥ 35 mph (unless in crosswalk).
- No clinging to vehicles while riding.

RESTRICTIONS

- No high-powered e-bikes/devices (750+ watts or >15 mph) on public property.
- No e-scooters on State highways.
- Age limits:
No e-scooters under 18 and no Class 3 e-bikes under 16.



Woodridge

WHAT TO KNOW:

- › DOT-approved helmets for all riders under 21 years.
- › No bikes or scooters with motors over 750 watts or off-highway motorcycles on all Village public property, including streets, alleys, sidewalks, bike paths, multi-use paths, and parking lots.
- › Standard traffic laws apply to riders of all e-bikes, e-scooters, mopeds, and gas bicycles.

WHO CAN RIDE

- › [E-Bikes \(Class 1,2,3\)](#) & **Gas Bikes**: Riders must be 16 years or older, consistent with Illinois law.
- › **E-Scooters**: Riders must be 18 years or older, consistent with Illinois law.



WHERE TO RIDE

- › [E-Bikes \(Class 1,2,3\)](#) & **Gas Bikes**: Streets, roadways, and bike paths where bicycles are authorized. E-Bikes are **not authorized** for use on sidewalks.
- › **E-Scooters**: Sidewalks, streets, roadways, and bike paths where bicycles are authorized.

PENALTIES:

- › A \$50 fine will be issued for the first offense.
- › Subsequent violations within a 12-month period may increase by \$15 or \$30.
- › Parents and legal guardians may also be held liable for minors and face fines.

Deerfield

It is unlawful for anyone under the age of 16, or who does not possess a driver's license, to operate a motor-driven vehicle on any street, sidewalk, path or any other public property within the Village of Deerfield.



Parents/caregivers are responsible for ensuring their child understands the restrictions and could be held responsible for any violations.

E-Bike Information

E-bike rules remain unchanged under the revised ordinance

All electric bicycles (e-bikes) must follow Illinois Vehicle Code, Rules of the Road and Village Ordinance

E-Bikes are not allowed on sidewalks

Riders 15 and under are required to wear a helmet at all times

Class 1 E-Bike

Low-speed electric bicycle equipped with a motor that provides assistance only when the rider is pedaling and ceases to provide assistance when the bicycle reaches speeds of 20 mph.

- No age requirement

Class 2 E-Bike

Low-speed electric bicycle equipped with a motor that can be used exclusively to propel the bicycle and cannot provide assistance when the bicycle reaches speeds of 20 mph.

- No age requirement

Class 3 E-Bike

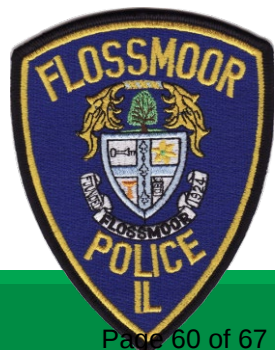
Low-speed electric bicycle equipped with a motor that provides assistance only when the rider is pedaling and ceases to provide assistance when the bicycle reaches a speed of 28 mph.

- Age requirement: 16+



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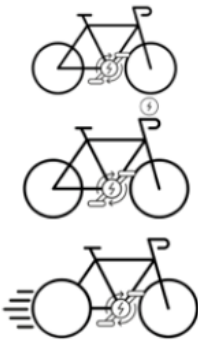

- ☐ **Produce print materials for distribution at schools and in the community.**
- ☐ **Online posts and information on Village website.**
- ☐ **Make educational stops instead of enforcement stops.**
- ☐ **Enforcement currently only according to state statute (limited) and FMC (200-1-11 [b]) Parental Responsibility.**



Intergovernmental Consideration

Notes from Discussions with Intergovernmental Partners

- ❑ Park District has had an uptick in complaints. Would partner on recommendations moving forward.
- ❑ SD161 discussed with principals and has seen an uptick in usage.
Would recommend some kind of enforcement with education.
- ❑ HF233, waiting on a response related to this topic.
- ❑ Village of Homewood, interested in our discussion and presentation, agrees with the importance of mirroring policies.
