Recognition

I would like to recognize a professional achievement by Commander Filkins. I would also like to introduce a newly appointed Sergeant and three Police Officers at our regular scheduled village meeting on December 15th, 2025.

The introduction of the new Police Officers and Sergeant will be followed by the ceremonial oath of office for each, administered by the Village Clerk.

Commander Tim Filkins: The Illinois Association of Chiefs of Police (IACP) is pleased to announce that Commander Tim Filkins has been designated as a **Certified Eligible Police Chief** through the Association's Police Chief Certification Program. This ILACP designation signifies that Commander Filkins has met their standards of competency and conduct for his profession.

To be eligible for consideration, Commander Filkins had to meet the ILACP's criteria for experience, education, professional membership, and community involvement. In the first phase of the certification process, Commander Filkins was evaluated on the basis of his extensive law enforcement experience, including command and executive posts, a solid educational background that encompasses continuing education and training, and his continuing participation in relevant professional and community organizations.

Commander Filkins then faced an examination panel consisting of two active Illinois Police Chiefs and a college professor specializing in Criminal Justice principles. The panel is designed to evaluate each candidate in the areas of leadership, management, public relations, ethics, police agency administration, and verbal communication.

Only those who have successfully completed all phases of the assessment process are designated a Certified Eligible Police Chief in Illinois by the ILACP.

Swearing-in Ceremonies

Sergeant David Levy has proudly served the Village of Flossmoor for his entire 18-year law enforcement career. A 2008 graduate of the Police Training Institute in Champaign, Illinois, Sergeant Levy distinguished himself early on by graduating first in his class.

Shortly after beginning his career, Sergeant Levy was selected to join the NET-3 Tactical Unit, a multi-jurisdictional criminal interdiction team comprised of officers from surrounding communities. This assignment was a direct reflection of his proactive police work, investigative skill, and professionalism. During his ten years with the unit, Sergeant Levy served as a street-level supervisor for eight years, where he helped lead and mentor officers from across multiple agencies.

Within the Flossmoor Police Department, Sergeant Levy has consistently demonstrated leadership

and dedication. He has served as both Acting Shift Leader and Shift Leader, positions that have prepared him well for his new role as Sergeant. Additionally, he is a member of the Field Training Unit, responsible for developing and guiding new officers to meet the high standards expected by the Village of Flossmoor.

Beyond his enforcement duties, Sergeant Levy is deeply committed to community engagement. He has played a major role in organizing and running the Citizen's Police Academy, founded Flossmoor's Shop With A Cop program, and serves as the emcee for the Village's annual National Night Out events. His efforts reflect a deep belief in the importance of building relationships with the residents and businesses of Flossmoor.

In 2024, Sergeant Levy was honored by his peers as Officer of the Year, a recognition that underscores the respect, confidence, and admiration his colleagues have for his leadership and character. Outside of work, Sergeant Levy enjoys spending time with his wife Stephanie, daughter Charlotte, and son Grayson. He also stays active in competitive sports, representing law enforcement with pride. He competes nationally in softball with the Chicago Metro Police Softball Team, which has earned three national titles, and in golf, where he has won three gold medals at the Can-Am Police & Fire Olympic Games.

Sergeant Levy's career reflects a balance of dedication to duty, commitment to professional excellence, and genuine care for the community he serves. The Village of Flossmoor is proud to celebrate his promotion and continued service as a leader within the Flossmoor Police Department.

Officer Jonathan Pennington was born in Chicago and raised in Olympia Fields. He attended Homewood-Flossmoor High School and began his interest in public service as a Matteson Police Cadet. He later earned a Bachelor's degree in Criminal Justice from Governors State University. Following his graduation, Pennington enlisted in the U.S. Army, serving two tours in Guantanamo Bay, Cuba, where he worked as a detention specialist. His civilian work experience includes employment with Target in Homewood as a Protection Specialist and seven years of service as a police officer in Olympia Fields.

During his tenure in Olympia Fields, Pennington served in several leadership and instructional roles, including Acting Officer in Charge, Field Training Officer, Use of Force Instructor, Firearms Instructor, Union President, and Pension Board President. Pennington credits his family as a constant source of support and motivation, encouraging him throughout his career to strive for excellence.

Officer Anthony Caldanaro is a Homewood native and 2024 graduate of the University of Mississippi who is committed to serving the community that shaped him. A former college baseball player, he thrives in competitive, team-oriented environments and brings discipline, resilience, and strong situational awareness to his work. He values positive community interactions and believes strong relationships are essential to effective policing. Anthony joined the Flossmoor Police Department in April 2025 and graduated from the Suburban Law Enforcement Academy in August. Anthony aims to bring integrity, dedication, and a community-focused approach to the Flossmoor Police Department.

Benjamin Barker is a former USAF Staff Sergeant with a passion for community involvement and emergency response. As a former full-time EMT, Benjamin still holds national certification through NREMT, and plans to use his skill set to help continue to serve this community in every way possible. Benjamin joined FLPD in April 2025, and proceeded to graduate the Suburban Law Enforcement Academy in August 2025. Benjamin resides in the area with his fiancé and 3 children.

REPORTS OF COMMITTEES, COMMISSIONS AND BOARDS ACTION ITEMS:

Mayor Nelson stated there were none. Mayor Nelson expressed her appreciation to the Village of Flossmoor Art Commission, Community Relations Commission, and Green Commission, and everyone who participated in the downtown ribbon cutting ceremony to celebrate the substantial completion of the streetscape and safety project.

ACTION ITEMS:

None.

DISCUSSION ITEMS

Agenda Item #6 Discussion on E-bike and E-scooter Regulations

This discussion item was presented by Jonathan Bogue, Assistant Village Manager. Mr. Bogue provided a detailed presentation about E-bikes and E-scooters that included a discussion on the following topics: (a) The rapid increase in usage rates for E-bikes and E-scooters; (b) State of Illinois laws for E-bikes and E-scooters and pending legislation; (c) Insurance/risk management recommendations from the Village's insurance and risk management association (IRMA) for E-bikes and E-scooters; (d) Research that shows an increased number of serious injuries associated with E-bikes and E-scooters; (e) The results of the Board survey on E-bikes and E-scooters; and (f) Age restriction recommendations for operators of E-bikes and E-scooters. Mr. Bogue advised the Board that Village staff recommends the Board consider: (1) Promoting educational resources about helmet use and safety guidelines to parents of minors who operate E-bikes and E-scooters; (2) A ban on E-scooters on the Village's downtown sidewalks; (3) Age requirements for Class 1 and Class 2 E-bikes; (4) Drafting E-bike and E-scooter regulations for the Village that is the same as what is passed by the State of Illinois; and (5) Local enforcement of violations related to any regulations passed by the Village for the operation and use of E-bikes and E-scooters.

Mayor Nelson, after Assistant Village Manager Bogue's presentation, advised that she agrees with the following: (1) Education and recommendations about helmet use without a mandatory helmet requirement for operators of E-bikes and E-scooters; (2) Publishing information about pending legislation with the State of Illinois related to the use of E-bikes and E-scooters, including any age restrictions for operators; (3) Enforcement by the Village for violations of local regulations related to E-bikes and E-scooters; (4) A ban on E-scooters on downtown Village sidewalks; and (5) Deferring any discussion and regulations related to age restrictions until the State of Illinois acts on pending legislation.

Mayor Nelson called for comments from the Trustees, and they made the following recommendations:

Trustee Dorsey: (1) Wait to see what the State of Illinois does with pending legislation for E-bikes and E-scooters before drafting local regulations so that the Village is able to mirror State regulations; (2) Local enforcement of violations that relate to local regulations for E-bikes and E-scooters; (3) Providing educational resources about helmets to parents of E-bike and E-scooter operators; (4) An age restriction based on what the State of Illinois will require for operators of E-bikes and E-scooters; and (5) Banning E-scooters on downtown Village sidewalks.

Trustee Lofton: (1) Waiting to see what the State of Illinois does with pending legislation on E-bikes and E-scooters so that any ordinances drafted and passed by the Village are consistent with Illinois law; (2) No E-scooters on downtown Village sidewalks; and (3) Helmet use since “one head injury can be your last.”

Trustee Mitros: (1) Agrees with overall comments with recommendations made during the presentation; (2) Local enforcement of Village regulations related to E-bikes and E-scooters; (3) No E-scooters on downtown Village sidewalks; and (4) Providing education about using helmets when operating E-bikes and E-scooters without making helmet use mandatory, in part because a mandatory helmet regulation will not be able to be enforced.

Trustee Mustafa: (1) A strong recommendation by the Village for helmet use without a mandatory requirement; (2) Following regulations imposed by the State of Illinois to the maximum extent possible and educating the public about these regulations; (3) Having a campaign that makes safety training attractive to young users of E-bikes and E-scooters. Assistant Village Manager Bogue advised that having a training program conducted solely by the Village comes with liability considerations that need to be evaluated; (4) Waiting to pass any age restrictions for operators of E-bikes and E-scooters pending State legislation; (5) A ban on E-scooters and E-bikes in the downtown area to limit congestion, and at a minimum, a ban on E-scooters on the downtown sidewalks. Assistant Manager Bogue advised that it was unlikely that E-bikes could be banned in the downtown area since these are legally operated on the street.

Trustee Rodgers: (1) Waiting for State legislation before passing local ordinances on E-bikes and E-scooters, including age restrictions for operators, so that any local ordinances are consistent with State law; (2) Strongly recommends operators of E-bikes and E-scooters wear a helmet, and agrees that helmets should not be a mandatory requirement; (3) Educating parents about safety issues related to E-bikes and E-scooters and State regulations; and (4) Banning E-scooters on downtown sidewalks.

Trustee Daggett: (1) Local enforcement of ordinance violations; (2) An E-bike and E-scooter ordinance that includes passenger restrictions if passenger restrictions are not addressed by State legislation; (3) Agrees overall with the recommendations from other Board members; and (4) Revisiting these issues when the State of Illinois acts on pending legislation.

Staff and the Village Attorney had direction to draft a local ordinance that mirrors State statute and prohibits E-scooters in the downtown area (B-5 zoning district).

RE: Consideration of an Ordinance of the Village of Flossmoor, Cook County, Illinois Amending Chapter 270 of the Village of Flossmoor Municipal Code (Parking Rules)

I am requesting an amendment to Chapter 270, Article 5 of the Flossmoor Municipal Code to clarify and strengthen specific parking regulations within the Village, particularly those related to marked parking stalls in the downtown corridor.

At present, multiple drivers park in a manner that occupies portions of two parking spaces, despite the parking lines in the downtown area being clearly and visibly marked. Vehicles parked on or over these lines prevent another motorist from safely utilizing the adjacent marked space. This practice reduces available parking, disrupts traffic flow, and creates avoidable congestion in the business district.

Because the current ordinance does not explicitly define parking over or outside of marked stall lines as a violation, the Police Department does not have the authority to issue a citation for what would otherwise be considered an improperly or illegally parked vehicle. This limits our ability to effectively manage and enforce orderly parking within our commercial areas.

To address this matter, the Police Department respectfully requests that the Village Board consider adoption of the following language:

Proposed Amendment Language

Section 1: Section 270-5-1 of Chapter 270, Article 5 of the Village of Flossmoor Municipal Code is hereby amended by deleting said Section 270-5-1 in its entirety and replacing it with the following:

§270-5-1. General; posting.

Parking rules shall be approved by the Board of Trustees. Approval may be passed and approved by motion unless otherwise required by law. Upon approval, notice of any regulations, restrictions or prohibitions approved by the Board of Trustees shall be by posting signs or any other reasonable means of notice. Where regulations, restrictions or prohibitions are applicable to an entire subdivision or are Village-wide, such regulations, restrictions or prohibitions shall be posted when practicable. No person shall park or otherwise operate a motor vehicle in contravention to a parking restriction.

Section 2: Section 270-5-1 of Chapter 270, Article 5 of the Flossmoor Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding the following parking restriction as letter “O” to said Section 270-5-2:

O. Parking outside of marked lines on any roadway or any municipal parking lot is prohibited.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.

The Police Department believes this amendment will provide the necessary clarity and enforcement authority to ensure parking spaces are utilized safely, efficiently, and as intended.

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF FLOSSMOOR, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS
AMENDING CHAPTERS 270 OF THE VILLAGE OF FLOSSMOOR MUNICIPAL CODE
(Parking Rules)**

WHEREAS, the Village of Flossmoor, Cook County, Illinois (the “Village”) is a duly organized and validly existing non-home-rule municipality created in accordance with the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970 and the laws of the State; and,

WHEREAS, Chapter 270, Article 5 of the Flossmoor Municipal Code provides for the parking of motor vehicles in the Village and all regulations, restrictions, and prohibitions pertaining thereto; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Trustees desire to amend Chapter 270, Article 5 of the Flossmoor Municipal Code to clarify certain parking regulations as hereinafter set forth.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Flossmoor, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: Section 270-5-1 of Chapter 270, Article 5 of the Village of Flossmoor Municipal Code is hereby amended by deleting said Section 270-5-1 in its entirety and replacing it with the following:

§270-5-1. General; posting.

Parking rules shall be approved by the Board of Trustees. Approval may be passed and approved by motion unless otherwise required by law. Upon approval, notice of any regulations, restrictions or prohibitions approved by the Board of Trustees shall be by posting signs or any other reasonable means of notice. Where regulations, restrictions or prohibitions are applicable to an entire subdivision or are Village-wide, such regulations, restrictions or prohibitions shall be

posted when practicable. No person shall park or otherwise operate a motor vehicle in contravention to a parking restriction.

Section 2: Section 270-5-1 of Chapter 270, Article 5 of the Flossmoor Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding the following parking restriction as letter “O” to said Section 270-5-2:

O. Parking outside of marked lines on any roadway or any municipal parking lot is prohibited.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.

Re: Public Act 104-0200 Amending Duties of Hearing Officer in Administration Adjudication Proceedings

On July 1, 2025, Governor Pritzker signed Public Act 104-0200 into law, effective January 1, 2026. This legislation added the following to the powers and duties of an Administrative Hearing Officer as listed in 1-2.1-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/1-2.1-4):

“(6) entering orders prohibiting further code violations or compelling the remediation of existing code violations within a specified time and authorizing the municipality to take all necessary steps to remediate code violations.”

This amendment to the statute authorizes the Hearing Officer, at the initial hearing on a code violation, to determine whether a code violation exists and, if found liable, to set a date by which the violator must remediate the violation. The Hearing Officer may also authorize and direct the municipality to take all necessary steps to remediate the violation if remediation has not occurred within the time specified without a second hearing on the matter.

This amendment, when read in conjunction with the provisions of Section 1-2.2-55(c) of the Illinois Municipal Code [(65 ILCS 5/1-2.2-55(c))], requires a second hearing, with notice not less than seven (7) days prior to the hearing date, for the sole purpose of fixing the costs incurred by the municipality to remediate the code violation. No longer is a hearing required to determine “whether the defendant has failed to comply with the judgment” thereby eliminating a step in the process before the municipality can assess its costs to remediate the code violation, and, if not paid within the time set by the hearing officer, should be a lien against the property in question.

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF FLOSSMOOR, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS
AMENDING CHAPTERS 35 OF THE VILLAGE OF FLOSSMOOR MUNICIPAL CODE**

(Administrative Judication)

WHEREAS, the Village of Flossmoor, Cook County, Illinois (the “Village”) is a duly organized and validly existing non-home-rule municipality created in accordance with the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970 and the laws of the State; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Trustees have determined that it is in the best interest of the Village to amend Chapter 35 to include the additional duties of the hearing officer as set forth in Public Act 104-0200.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Flossmoor, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: Section 35-1-2 B (2) is hereby amended by deleting said Section in its entirety and replacing it with the following new 35-1-2 B (2):

- (2) The powers and duties of a hearing officer shall include:
- (a) Hearing testimony and accepting evidence that is relevant to the existence of the code violation;
 - (b) Issuing subpoenas directing witnesses to appear and give relevant testimony at the hearing, upon the request of the parties or their representatives;
 - (c) Preserving and authenticating the record of the hearing and all exhibits and evidence introduced at the hearing;
 - (d) Issuing a determination, based on the evidence presented at the hearing, of whether a code violation exists. The determination shall be in writing and shall include a written finding of fact, decision, and order including the fine, penalty, or action with which the defendant must comply;
 - (e) Imposing penalties consistent with applicable code provisions and assessing costs upon finding a party liable for the charged violation, except, however, that in no event shall the hearing officer have authority to (i) impose a penalty of incarceration, or (ii) impose a fine in excess of \$50,000, or at the option of the municipality. The maximum monetary fine under this item (e), shall be exclusive of costs of enforcement or costs imposed to secure

compliance with the municipality's ordinances and shall not be applicable to cases to enforce the collection of any tax imposed and collected by the municipality; and

- (f) Entering orders prohibiting further code violations or compelling the remediation of existing code violations within a specified time and authorizing the municipality to take all necessary steps to remediate code violations.
- (g) Upon a finding of liable a \$30 penalty may be imposed by the hearing officer as an administrative cost. This penalty may also be imposed upon dismissal of any alleged ordinance violation.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.

RE: Consideration of an Ordinance for the Levy and Assessment of Taxes for the Fiscal Year Beginning May 1, 2025 and Ending April 30, 2026 of the Village of Flossmoor, County of Cook, State of Illinois

On November 17, 2025, the Village Board established an estimated 2025 tax levy, thereby allowing the Village to adopt the final levy at the December 15, 2025, Board Meeting. Attached for approval is the 2025 Tax Levy Ordinance.

The Tax Levy Ordinance has been prepared in accordance with the estimated levy approved by the Board on November 17. As discussed on November 17, the Village levy of \$8,121,118 results in a 4.84% increase in dollars as compared to the 2024 extension. The percentage increase without the 2014 General Obligation and 2021 General Obligation (referendum and refunding purposes) Bond Issues is 6.48%. The CPI portion of the increase is limited to a tax-cap imposed of 2.9%. The remaining portion represents the Village's new property growth, which includes a factor this year for new developments consisting of Oasis Refuge and Rainbow Cone. The total levy per the ordinance, which includes the Flossmoor Public Library, is \$9,736,734. The total levy will not be offset by any bond issue abatement this year, as there was insufficient excess accumulation in the Debt Service Fund.

Please place approval of the 2025 Tax Levy Ordinance on the December 15, 2025 Village Board Meeting agenda. Approval of the 2025 Tax Levy Ordinance should be placed on the agenda in an order that precedes the resolution directing the Cook County Clerk on the reduction of the 2025 levy.

RE: **Consideration of a Resolution Directing the Cook County Clerk for Reduction of the 2025 Tax Levy in the Event Tax Cap Limitations are Exceeded by the Village of Flossmoor, County of Cook, State of Illinois**

Tax cap legislation that became effective with the 1994 levy provides the County Clerk with a mechanism to reduce tax levies upon extension if the tax levy extension exceeds the tax cap calculations. Absent specific direction from the taxing body, the County Clerk reduces each levy category other than debt service and non-capped fire pension proportionately. The taxing body can, however, file a resolution along with the tax levy ordinance that directs the County Clerk to reduce the levy in a manner other than proportionate. Such direction is effective for one specific tax levy and is, therefore, not perpetual.

Since the implementation of tax caps, the Village has used a strategy to maximize its tax levy by including estimates of new property growth. The Village's new property estimates have typically been aggressive from the standpoint of trying to capture all new property value. This approach has almost always resulted in an overestimate. Beginning with the 2000 levy, the Village has annually passed specific direction to the County Clerk regarding reduction of the Village's levy. Since the 2000 levy, the Village has generally been able to at least recognize either the full maximum allowable levy amounts (rates) as determined by the tax cap extension or the full levy ordinance amounts. With 2023 being a rising EAV levy year, the Village was able to recognize the maximum allowable levy, but not the ordinance amounts or the statutory maximum ceiling rates. This is generally due to EAV rising at a pace faster than the overall cap.

As discussed at the November 17, 2025, Board meeting, the approved 2025 levy estimate presents a situation where all three "capped-ceiling" lines are unlikely to be extended for the full "maximum allowable levy" amounts (i.e., ceiling rates). In order to minimize the impact of the 2025 "capped-ceiling" levy lines possibly being reduced further below their statutory maximum ceiling rates, the attached resolution should be approved for the 2025 tax levy, as was done last year. The resolution directs the County Clerk, in the event of the 2025 tax levy exceeding tax cap calculations at extension, to reduce the levy in a manner which does not reduce the three "capped-ceiling" levy lines below the amounts levied by the Village Board (subject, of course, to the maximum allowable levy per the 2025 EAV). If a reduction is needed, the levy would be reduced proportionately among the "non-ceiling" lines.

Please place approval of the attached resolution on the December 15, 2025 Village Board Meeting agenda in an order that follows approval of the 2025 Tax Levy Ordinance.

RE: **Consideration of a Resolution of the Village of Flossmoor, Cook County, Illinois Approving a Purchase Agreement with Sentinel Emergency Solutions for the Purchase of a Fire Engine**

The Fire Department respectfully requests that the Village Board authorize the Village Manager to enter into an agreement with Sentinel Emergency Solutions for the purchase of a Rosenbauer custom fire engine through the Houston–Galveston Area Council (H-GAC) cooperative purchasing program. The Village of Flossmoor is an active member of H-GAC through Resolution 2024-25 and has successfully utilized this cooperative for previous purchases. This planned acquisition appears in the FY 2028–2029 Capital Improvement Schedule and represents a substantial and strategically timed investment in the Village’s fire apparatus fleet.

The Flossmoor Fire Department maintains a strong and proven partnership with Sentinel Emergency Solutions. Sentinel supplied the Rosenbauer ladder truck currently serving the Village of Flossmoor, an apparatus that has demonstrated exceptional reliability, operational performance, and suitability for our community’s emergency response needs. This history of success provides a high level of confidence in Sentinel’s continued ability to support the Village of Flossmoor through the procurement, construction, and long-term service life of the new custom engine.

Across the fire apparatus industry, sustained national demand and supply-chain pressures have extended production lead times for custom engines to 36-48 months. To secure a build position and protect the Village from further market-driven cost increases, it is essential to sign the agreement now. This proactive approach supports the Village’s long-range capital planning and ensures the fire department maintains a reliable frontline fleet without unexpected budget impacts.

Earlier this year, the Village sold an engine for \$390,000. These proceeds offset the quoted Rosenbauer purchase price of \$1,002,813, resulting in a net impact of \$612,813 to the fund over the next few years. Similar proposals from other manufacturers for the same specifications ranged from \$1.2 to \$1.45 million so this H-GAC proposal is an excellent value for the Village. This outcome reflects prudent financial management and shows the effectiveness of the Village’s budgeting model in securing long-term capital equipment.

Once put into service, the new engine will offer over twenty years of reliable operation and is built to meet modern safety, performance, and NFPA standards. Moving forward with this purchase now protects the Village from rising future costs, ensures continuity of emergency services, and upholds the high operational standards our residents expect.

For these reasons, the fire department recommends that the Village Board authorize the Village Manager to enter into an agreement with Sentinel Emergency Solutions for the future purchase of a Rosenbauer custom fire engine through the H-GAC cooperative purchasing program for \$1,002,813.00, with acquisition and payment scheduled for FY 2028–2029 as outlined in the Village’s capital equipment replacement plan. Early authorization strengthens the Village’s financial

position, secures critical production capacity, and reaffirms the Village's commitment to responsible long-term planning and exceptional public safety services.

WHEREAS, the Village of Flossmoor, Cook County, Illinois (the "*Village*"), is a duly organized and validly existing non-home rule municipality created in accordance with the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970 and the laws of the State; and

WHEREAS, Sentinel Emergency Solutions is in the business of selling Rosenbauer fire apparatus through the Houston-Galveston Area Council ("*H-GAC*") cooperative purchasing program; and

WHEREAS, the Village approved participation in the H-GAC pursuant to Resolution No. 2024-25 for the purchase of Fire Department equipment and apparatus; and

WHEREAS, Sentinel Emergency Solutions supplied the Village with a Rosenbauer ladder truck currently used by the Flossmoor Fire Department, and said truck is a reliable and high-performing piece of apparatus that the Fire Department has been pleased with; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Department finds it necessary to purchase a new fire engine to adequately protect and serve the community; and

WHEREAS, Sentinel Emergency Solutions has provided the Village with a quote for a Rosenbauer fire engine to be delivered to the Village during the 2028-2029 fiscal year, for a price of \$1,002,813.00 (the "*Purchase Agreement*"); and

WHEREAS, the Village sold an old fire engine earlier this year for \$390,000, the proceeds of which will be applied to the purchase of the new fire engine, resulting in a net cost to the Village of \$612,813 for the new fire engine; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief and Village Manager recommend that the Purchase Agreement with Sentinel Emergency Solutions for a custom fire engine be approved by the Mayor and Board of Trustees at a price of \$1,002,813.00 to secure the Village's build position place for acquisition during the 2028-2029 fiscal year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Flossmoor, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby incorporated in this Resolution as the findings of the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Flossmoor.

Section 2. That the terms of the Purchase Agreement with Sentinel Emergency Solutions, as attached hereto and made a part hereof, be approved, and the

Flossmoor Fire Department is hereby authorized to proceed with the acquisition.

Section 3. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.
